



## School Uniform Policy

We are very proud of our school uniform, as it can play a key role in:

- promoting the ethos of a school;
- providing a sense of belonging and identity;
- setting an appropriate tone for education.

**Below are the details of our uniform. Where possible, we have tried to give alternatives which can reduce the cost overall.**

### Autumn/Spring Term

Mab's Cross check skirt or pinafore (available at Impressions, Standish or Slaters)

Grey trousers

Pale blue shirt cotton shirt

Mab's Cross tie – elastic or clip (available at Impressions or Slaters)

Navy blue sweater with school logo (available at Impressions or Slaters)

Footwear - dark shoes (low heels) - no trainers please.

### Summer Term

**Light** blue gingham checked dresses

Grey short trousers (if preferred to long)

Pale blue cotton shirt and tie

Navy blue sweater with school logo.

No jewellery is allowed except for a watch

Hair styles should be traditional and appropriate. Inappropriate hair colours such as blue, orange or green are not permitted.

### P.E.

On P.E. days children come to school wearing their P.E. kit, as follows:

A pair of pumps or trainers

Our school navy P.E. t-shirt, with embroidered school logo (available at Impressions and Slaters),  
**or** a plain navy t-shirt

Navy blue shorts (not cycling shorts or Nike Pro type)

For cooler days we have a new school tracksuit, embroidered with our logo, available from the suppliers above. **Alternatively**, children can wear plain navy jogging bottoms or leggings (no logos) and their school jumper.

Children who attend the swimming baths will require appropriate swimwear and a towel. All children with long hair should have a swimming cap.
